






While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.


HOW TO USE A HIDDEN CAM & CAM SCREW OR CAM DOWEL









Push four LARGE HIDDEN CAMS (3) into the large holes in the LEFT END (C) and LEFT UPRIGHT (D).



Insert twelve WOOD DOWELS (6) into the FIXED SHELVES (J) and SKIRT (K).







Fasten the FIXED SHELVES (J) and SKIRT (K) to the LEFT UPRIGHT (D). Use four GOLD 1-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).

NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SHELVES and SKIRT insert into the UPRIGHT. GOLD 1- 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREW (4 used in this step) **(4**) Open end


- Fasten the LEFT END (C) to the FIXED SHELVES (J) and SKIRT (K). Use four GOLD 1-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the SHELVES and SKIRT insert into the UPRIGHT.




Push four LARGE HIDDEN CAMS (3) into the large holes in the RIGHT UPRIGHT (E) and RIGHT END (F).




- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (6) into the SMALL MODESTY PANEL (H).
- Fasten the SMALL MODESTY PANEL (H) to the LEFT UPRIGHT (D). Use two GOLD 1- 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- Fasten the RIGHT UPRIGHT (E) to the SMALL MODESTY PANEL (H). Use two GOLD 1- 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the MODESTY PANEL insert into the UPRIGHTS.




- Insert four WOOD DOWELS (6) into the LARGE MODESTY PANEL (R).
- Fasten the LARGE MODESTY PANEL (R) to the MOLDING (G). Use two GOLD 1- 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- Fasten the RIGHT END (F) to the LARGE MODESTY PANEL (R). Use two GOLD 1- 3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).




- Carefully stand your two assemblies upright.
- Insert two WOOD DOWELS (6) into the MOLDING (G).
- Fasten the RIGHT UPRIGHT (E) to the MOLDING (G). Use two GOLD 1-3/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (14).
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the MOLDING insert into the RIGHT UPRIGHT.
- Insert eight WOOD DOWELS (6) into the ENDS (C and F) and UPRIGHTS (D and E).




- Turn six CAM SCREWS (5) into the LARGE TOP (A).
- Fasten the METAL PLATE (10) and TIE PLATE (11) to the TOP (A). Use four GOLD 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (17).



- Fasten the TOP (A) to the LEFT END (C) and UPRIGHTS (D and E). Tighten six HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the END and UPRIGHTS insert into the TOP.




Turn two CAM SCREWS (5) into the SMALL TOP (B).




- Fasten the SMALL TOP (B) to the RIGHT END (F). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the WOOD DOWELS in the END insert into the TOP.
- Fasten the SMALL TOP (B) to the LARGE TOP (A). Use four GOLD 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (17) through the METAL PLATES, TIE PLATES, and into the SMALL TOP.







Push four SMALL HIDDEN CAMS (4) into the large holes in the DRAWER SIDES (M and N).



Fasten the EXTENSION SLIDES (2) to the DRAWER SIDES (M and N). Use six GOLD 1/2" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (17) through the holes shown in the enlarged diagram.



Turn four CAM SCREWS (5) into the DRAWER FRONT (L).




Fasten the DRAWER SIDES (M and N) to the DRAWER FRONT (L). Tighten four SMALL HIDDEN CAMS.

tap the DRAWER BOTTOM down into the groove.

With the palm of your hand,


Slide a DRAWER BOTTOM (P) into the grooves in the DRAWER SIDES (M and N) and DRAWER FRONT (L).




Groove

- Fasten the DRAWER BACK (O) to the DRAWER SIDES (M and N). Use four GOLD 1-1/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (15).
- NOTE: Be sure the DRAWER BOTTOM (P) inserts into the groove of the DRAWER BACK (O).


Fasten a PULL (7) to the DRAWER FRONT (L). Use two SILVER 15/16" PAN HEAD SCREWS (16).




- Push the four BRACKETS (12) onto the DRAWER SIDES (M and N).
- Slide the two FILE BARS (13) into the BRACKETS (12) as shown in the enlarged diagram.
- Hang your letter files on the FILE BARS (13) as shown.




- Make equal margins along all four edges of the BACK (Q). Push on opposite corners of your unit if needed to make it "square".
- Fasten the BACK (Q) to your unit using the NAILS (9). The NAILS should be 4" apart and 1/4" in from the edges.
- Peel APPLIQUES from the APPLIQUE CARD (8) and stick them onto each visible HIDDEN CAM





- To insert a drawer into your unit, line up the EXTENSION SLIDES on the drawer with the EXTENSION RAILS on the unit and push the drawer into the unit until the drawer is fully inserted. The drawer will push in hard until it is all the way in, then it will slide in and out easier.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.



Look out for:	What can happen:	How to avoid the problem:
 Overloaded shelves or drawers. Improper loading can cause the product to be top-heavy. 	 Risk of injury. Top-heavy furniture can tip over. Overloaded shelves and drawers can break. 	 Never exceed the weight limits shown in the instructions. Work from bottom to top when loading shelves and drawers. Place the heavier items on the lower shelves or in lower drawers.
• Improperly moving furniture that is not designed and equipped with casters.	 Furniture can tip over or break if improperly moved. Physical injury. Furniture can be very heavy. Breakage of tops - particularly with double pedestal furniture (drawers at both ends). 	 Unload shelves and drawers from top to bottom before moving the unit. Do not push furniture, especially on a carpeted floor. Have a friend help you lift the item and set it in place. Provide support to the center section of the top when lifting the furniture.
